Recommended Courses for Majors Planning to Transfer to WVU

Students planning to transfer from Thomas Nelson Community College to West Virginia University should complete courses that will satisfy WVU's major requirements and facilitate timely degree completion. Students who do not complete these courses may require an additional year due to course sequencing issues. Courses in blue are encouraged—they
